General Rules:

1. Any member of WApHC in good standing may nominate one or more entries in the futurity.
2. All owners and exhibitors of nominated horses must be members of WApHC. **Membership must be paid before Futurity paperwork is submitted. You may submit the membership application along with the Futurity information.**
3. In case of a leased mare for weanling nomination, the legal papers from Moscow must be sent with nomination.
4. All entries must be registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club, Moscow, Idaho. Horses with NC papers are allowed only in the weanling division. All others **MUST** have show papers.
5. In the case of change of ownership, the futurity rights remain with the horse. The new owner must be a member of WApHC and the Futurity Chairman must have show papers.
6. **NO SUBSTITUTIONS** will be allowed for nominated horses.
7. All payments are due on or before the due dates. The postmark will determine the date of mailed payment.
8. Copies of **BOTH** sides of the horse's registration papers **MUST** accompany **ALL** nominations. In the case of weanlings, copies of **BOTH** sides of the **MARE'S** papers are **REQUIRED** plus the **STALLION'S NAME** and **REGISTRATION NUMBER**.
 - A. To be a legal nomination, copies of registration papers **MUST** accompany payment.
 - B. Nominations without proper funds or paperwork will be returned to the nominating member for correction and payment of **ADDITIONAL FEES** if required.
9. All **WEANLING** nominations **MUST** have a **NOMINATION FORM** with **EACH** payment or they might get put in the wrong class or not in a class at all.
10. Original papers or copies of original papers are **REQUIRED** for each entry on the **DAY** of the Futurity for weanlings. Both sides are required if a copy is used. All other papers must accompany your nomination forms.
11. Non-Pros must carry current year card to be eligible for Non-pro monies. Non-pro cards will be checked the day of the futurity.
12. All nominations will be shown in the corresponding open class and are required to pay the open class fee.
13. All entries must show under all judges.
14. Regarding nomination of stallions and/or geldings, once nominated as a stallion, the horse can be transferred to gelding division provided that the Futurity Chairman is notified in writing prior to the show.
15. The governing board consisting of two or more members from WApHC and the Futurity Chairman must approve all Futurity rule changes.
16. Nominated weanling monies will be divided by proper sex. The monies from foals of unknown sex will be divided evenly.
17. If you scratch or are unable to show you **CAN NOT** get your money back!
18. Unless previously stated, the Wisconsin State Appaloosa Futurity follows the rules and guidelines of the ApHC.
19. **If there is only one horse in a Futurity Class you will be refunded your money and the class will be cancelled.**
20. **There will be no REFUNDS for any reason, with the exception of aborting or still born.**

WApHC Board Meeting Minutes

Teleconference

January 12, 2014

Attendees: Kim Klinkner, Nick Beil, Terie Clark, Jess Fale, Tina Mahloch, Stephanie Jacobson, Brenda Weyers, Courtney Rozmenoski

Meeting is called to order at 7:02 PM.

Treasurer's Report:

Nick emailed treasurer's report to board members. Current balance is \$3,476.34. Of that amount, the youth club currently has \$332.37.

NEWPHA Show:

- Show bill needs to be emailed by March 1st to Shelley Blaies and she will make the copies for the booklets.
- Our club again voted no to having a booth at Horse A Rama.
- Rachel Rhein (President) is looking into setting up teleconference meetings. Feb & March meetings would be teleconference and April will be in person at Denny's.
- Chelsea will make the show bill and email it to the board for our approval.
- Tina is working on booking the judge. She is looking at hiring Megan Garcia.
- Membership list needs to be emailed to Gloria Schaut so that she can keep track of points for NEWPHA.
- Officers for 2014 are: Rachel Rhein is president, Gloria Schaut is Vice President, Maryann Biel is treasurer and Brenda Weyers is secretary.
- Brenda is going to be the show chair for this show however she will not be able to attend the show as it is her daughter's graduation.
- Spirit Horse Club rejoined NEWPHA. July 20th is going to be their show in Manitowoc.
- The last show of the year will no longer be doubled judged.
- Daryl Mahloch's family has volunteered to run the food booth for our show. Tina will be taking care of getting the food license.

Spring Show:

- We discussed having our jackpot classes being open to all breeds.
 - *Nick makes motion to have the jackpot classes open to all breeds. 2nd by Steph. All in favor.*
 - *Brenda makes motion to have the open jackpot classes be 4 classes which would be Walk Trot Western Pleasure, Walk Trot English Pleasure, Western Pleasure & English Pleasure. 2nd by Steph. All in favor except Kim. Motion approved.*
- Judges are booked and Tina will email the board who they are going to be.
- We discussed changing our order of classes.
 - It was discussed on Saturday starting with English classes (HIH and HUS and Eq) and then running trail and then speed and then cattle (but cattle would be worded that it would not start before say 4 PM). Then on Sunday it would be all the halter and showmanship and western pleasure and Eq.

- Cattle would need to be pre-paid 2 weeks in advance so that we can make the cattle appropriate for the exhibitors.
 - Terie said that at other shows for the cattle pre entry they just prepay the cattle fee charge.
- *Nick makes motion that cattle needs to be registered & paid 2 week in advance. 2nd by Kim. All approve.*

Fall Show:

- Tina and Nick want to add around 20 open classes to start the day off on Saturday (so like a small open show). We are all split on this so we need to look into this further. Nick and Chelsea are going to put together a list of classes (fake show bill) so that we can see if this is even feasible to have.

Escanaba Show:

- Show is August 30th & 31st with 2 judges. This was approved at the last meeting.
- This show is going to be one day as a regional show and one day as an open show.
- *Nick makes motion to run cattle on Friday night and pay 2 judges with half day fees. Saturday would be registered classes with speed being combined registered/open and Sunday will be open show. 2nd by Terie. All in favor except Kim abstained.*
- Package fee will be \$80.
- Terie is talking about sponsorships. We have \$10 for sponsorships. And \$50 would be if they wanted to hang a banner.

Miscellaneous:

- Year-end nominations:
 - Steph would like to have a lump sum of around \$50 or \$60 and then members are nominated for all classes. This would be per category (youth, non pro, open).
 - *Nick makes motion to have \$50 lump sum that can be paid per category for regional nominations for year ends. Courtney made 2nd. All in favor.*
- Class approved shows:
 - The 3 Freedom shows, Get Spotted, Long Creek Club, Blackhawk, Mississippi Valley, WISSOTA, Iowa Club.
- Midwest Horse Fair:
 - Discussed having packets put together by Chelsea. We do want to do this and also have it where people can advertise in it if they would like. Business cards \$10, ¼ page \$20, ½ page \$30, full page \$50.

Next meeting will be February 16th via teleconference at 7 PM.

Meeting adjourned at 9 PM.

WApHC Board Meeting Minutes

Teleconference

February 16, 2014

Attendees: Tina Mahloch, Nick Beil, Stephanie Jacobson, Terie Clark, Brenda Weyers, Jess Fale, Kim Klinkner

Meeting is called to order at 7:05 PM.

Treasurer's Report:

Nick emailed treasurer's report to board members. Current balance is \$2,390.50. *Kim makes motion to approve this amount. 2nd by Steph. All in favor.*

NEWPHA:

- Brenda has everything in order at this time for the show.
- At the last NEWPHA meeting it was decided that they did want to have a booth at horse a rama. Our delegates stated that our club voted no on this and that nobody would be available to work at the booth.
- We need to start thinking about 1st place awards. These should be under \$5.

Black River Falls Show:

- Tina would like to add masters trail to our show bills. *Steph makes motion to add. 2nd by Brenda. All in favor.*
- Food Booth – Tina will call the woman she spoke with to get a number for the food wagon. This place does other horse shows at this facility.
- Nick will be the show secretary, Kim will be show manager, Daryl be listed as ring steward.

Marshfield Show:

- Need to add masters trail to our show bill.
- Chelsea sent out a show bill showing how the classes would be if we would have an open show before the registered show.
 - Kim and Brenda are not in favor of this.
 - Nick believes this could be easy money.
- We had discussion on how if the open show were to happen that the show bill needs to be different as it was felt that having all the regional classes in one day (Sunday) would be way too long and hard on both horses and exhibitors and it would run too late. Also people then wouldn't have to come for the weekend and we would be out money for stalls. We discussed rearranging the order of classes. Rearranging the classes does make this sound better, however not all board members were on board.
 - *Nick makes motion to have the show bill order as follows:*
 - *Saturday:*
 - *Open show (including Open Appaloosa Halter)*
 - *Regional show: trail, western pleasure, western horsemanship, cattle (not to start before 5) and then games/speed.*

▪ **Sunday:**

- *Regional Show: halter, showmanship, hunter in hand, english showmanship, english HUS, english equitation, saddle seat equitation, saddle seat pleasure, Hunter Hack.*

2nd by Steph. In favor are Nick, Steph, Tina, Terie & Jess. Opposed is Kim. Brenda abstained. Motion passed.

- Steph thinks that the jackpot classes should be done during the open show portion of this show. *Nick makes motion to move jackpot classes to open portion. 2nd by Steph. All in favor.*
- Nick brought up paying 1st-6th place instead of ribbons for the open classes.
 - Steph said this will cost more than ribbons.
 - Tina said it's better to have show bucks than actual money.
 - *Terie makes motion to give out ribbon 1st – 6th and then they could turn in their ribbon for something from the grab bucket. 2nd by Nick. All in favor.*
- Nick will have the boy scouts do the food booth again this year.

Escanaba Show:

- Nick as contacted person, show secretary will be Nick, Show manager will be Terie, Ring Steward Mira Acevedo.
- Need to add masters trail.
- Terie will be sending the open rule book to Tina so she can forward to the judges.

Miscellaneous:

- Chelsea will put in newsletter that we are looking for help.
- Tina said that she found some jackets and vests that were approx 60% off at Menards in a variety of sizes and colors. She thought this would be a good purchase to make so that we can use these items to have them embroidered for high point awards, year end awards and possibly the NEWPHA banquet awards. *Nick makes motion to buy the menards clearance jackets and vests for no more than \$640. 2nd by Terie. All in favor.*

March 22nd will be our next meeting which will be a general membership meeting (Chelsea will make note of this in our upcoming newsletter). It will be held at Meadow Lanes West in Manitowoc, WI. This will be a 1 PM meeting with bowling optional after.

Kim makes motion to adjourn meeting at 9:05 PM. 2nd by Terie. All in favor.
